 - 4.2 Mrs K Longhurst-Prior – Mrs Longhurst-Prior is asking for permission of the Parish Council to be able to park a horse van on the car park at the village hall in a discreet space. Mrs Longhurst-Prior’s daughter who lives with us has just turned 17 and we now have her car here too. There is no space currently on the farm where they keep their horse to keep the van. However, they would like to keep it close to hand as they use it most weekends and should an emergency arise, they would need to get to it quickly should they need to get the horse to veterinary care. Therefore, they request to park it as tucked away as possible in the hall car park. Councillors have signed posted to the Coronation Hall Committee.
